The ASSA ABLOY family of premium cast iron door closers includes the Corbin Russwin DC8000, the Norton 9500 and the SARGENT 281. These adjustable sized (1-6), non-handed, big body closers offer a full complement of forged steel arm options and are intended for use in institutional environments. All carry ANSI/BHMA A156.4 Grade 1 certification and are UL listed for labeled fire doors. With many of the same features as competitive offerings, they do offer some notable advantages:

Quality Construction and Design

ASSA ABLOY cast iron closers are single-piece cast construction. This provides uniform strength and eliminates a leak point found in competitive products that use a cast iron housing connected to a steel tube.

The Corbin Russwin DC8000, Norton 9500 and SARGENT 281 designs all have internal pressure relief valves as a standard feature. Pressure relief valves for both the opening and closing cycle absorb excess force and maintain control of the door. For instance, if a user attempts to aggressively slam a door or push through the closer's closing cycle, pressure relief valves absorb the impact of that force. The door will move only marginally faster — it will not slam — with the pressure relieve valve acting as a shock absorber. Competitive closers without pressure relief valves can't absorb this force and stall through the closing motion, transferring that force to the mounting points, ripping out arm brackets and damaging the door or frame. When the competitive closer stalls, it in effect reduces its overall closing speed, so in an emergency a user may not get the door closed in time.

The quality of our designs is also evidenced in our cycle count testing. Our UL witnessed test of 25 million cycles is dated February 2015. The date of the test is important as it reflects the design's revision — some competitors have not retested in over twenty years! We don't believe in standing still and our cycle test continues to run.

Installation and Adjustment

Superior product design is only part of the story; installation and adjustment of door closers are of great importance as well. Cast iron closers are heavy, and for that reason ASSA ABLOY products feature a separate mounting plate so installers don't have to balance the full weight of the closer while securing it to the opening.

Ease of installation

- Separate mounting plate helps ease installation

Ease of adjustment

- Valves are always easily accessible

The location of our valves is carefully chosen to ensure that they are always accessible (competitors' offerings sometimes require removing the unit from the door to adjust). The valves themselves are brass with a 1/8" hex drive so that the head doesn't strip out. The competitors' valves, in contrast, use zinc and a tiny 3/32" hex.

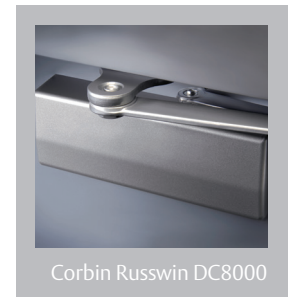
Aesthetics
