MR Credit- Construction Waste Management

ABH packaging is produced, primarily from recycled materials. In an effort to reduce the amount of waste routed to landfills, ABH® works to minimize the amount of packaging it uses as well as work with its customers seeking to extend responsibility for proper recycling and disposal of our packaging after products have been used.

MR Credit 4- Recycled Content: ABH® products are manufactured using metals mixed of virgin and recycled materials to reduce impacts on the environment from extracting and processing of strictly virgin metals.
